

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Perrysville, Indiana that:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful to keep, own or harbor any horses, mules, jacks, cattle, swine, sheep or any other livestock within the platted ares of the Town of Perrysville, Indiana, or within two hundred (200) feet of any dwelling or other building inhabited by human beings.

Section 2.

No horses, mules, jacks, cattle, swine, sheep or any other livestock of any kind shall be permitted to run at large within the Town of Perrysville, Indiana.

Section 3.

The town may sell or otherwise dispose of any livestock permitted to sum at large in violation of this ordinance, and may in addition to criminal penalties hereinafter provided, enforce any part of this ordinance by civil action for damages or by procedure to abate a nuisance shall constitute a nuisance per se.

Section 4.

Anyone violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offence.

Section 5.


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
