

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN THE TOWN OF PERRYSVILLE, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Perrysville, Vermillion County, Indiana, as follows:

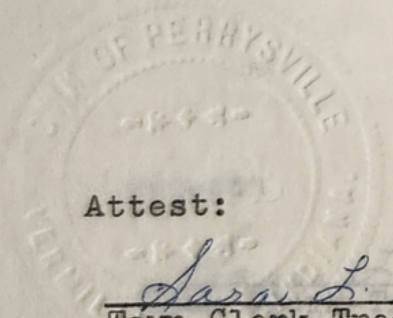
Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any dog or dogs to run at large within the town, not in the care of their masters or other persons delegated to care for them.

Section 2. The Town Marshal is hereby instructed to kill on sight any and all dogs running at large.

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on June 1, 1968.
