

ORDINANCE


An ordinance making it an unlawful act to ride, drive or propel in any manner any vehicle or bicycle upon any sidewalks within the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Vermillion County, Indiana, and providing for penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville in Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons whomsoever to drive, ride or propel in any manner any vehicle or bicycle upon any of the sidewalks of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, except in the necessary crossing of said sidewalks. And providing further that any such person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) for each offense.

This ordinance passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, this 4th day of June, 1937.
