RESOLUTION REGARDING WATER USAGE  
BY THE PERRYSVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Town Council of the Town of Perrysville, Vermillion County, Indiana, in accordance with the authority granted under IC 36-5-2-9 and in keeping with past Councils practice, has determined that in exchange for services rendered by the Perrysville Volunteer Fire Department regarding the inspection, auditing and reporting on the Perrysville Water Works hydrants, that there will be no charge for water from the Perrysville Water Works either for emergency situations, such as fire fighting or usage necessary to maintain a fire station for general office and training needs.

Another usage by the forementioned Department such as the filling of residential wells or swimming pools, shall be charged in accordance with Ordinance 1996-1, (water rates).
