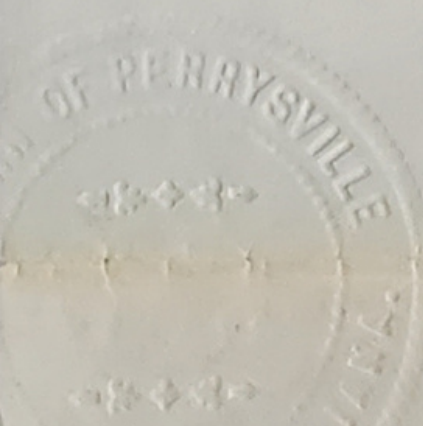

An ordinance providing for the regulation of the display, discharge or setting off of fire works within the corporate limits of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, ^{Township} Highland, Vermillion County, Indiana, and perscribing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons whomsoever to fire, set off, discharge, shoot, and/or display in any manner any fire works within the limits of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, until forty eight (48) hours before one minute past 12:00 o'clock A. M. on the 4th day of July, 1937, and each consecutive year thereafter. And providing further that any such person or persons whomsoever violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) for each offense.

This ordinance passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Perrysville, Highland Township, Vermillion County, Indiana, this 4th day of June, 1937.
