## Town of Perrysville Ordinance No. 98-2

## An Ordinance Prohibiting Customers From Tampering With Water Meters Or Turning On Water Without Permission

WHEREAS, some customers of the Town of Perrysville's water utility have been tampering with the Town's water meters and turning on the water themselves without permission for the Town; and

WHEREAS, such actions can result in damage to the Town's property and can result in customers obtaining water from the Town without the Town's knowledge or concent;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Perrysville, Indiana:

- 1. No person shall tamper with the Town's water meters. No person other than an authorize employee of the Town of Perrysville shall turn on the water to supply a business or residential customer with water.
- 2. The employess of the Town of Perrysville are authorized and directed to install tags on the Town's water meters notifying persons of the provisions of this Ordinance.
- 3. Any person who violates Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$50. and not more than \$1000.00. In addition, if any person violates Section 1 of this Ordinance, the employees of the Town of Perrysville are authorized and directed to turn off the water supply to such person's residence or business until otherwise directed by the officers of the Town.

## THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS PUBLICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.
